### Chapter 4 – God Never Gives Up

Key verse, verse 17; *so that the living may know that the Most High is sovereign over all kingdoms on earth and gives them to anyone he wishes and sets over them the lowliest of people.* This praise of God's sovereignty is throughout chapter 4 of Daniel. It's repeated in verse 25, 32 and 34. The whole point of Nebuchadnezzar's dream, the interpretation of the dream and then the fulfillment of the dream, was to show that God is most high. Daniel's God is sovereign, He rules, and He is the One who gives power to man and He chooses who will receive it.

#### Nine lessons from Daniel, chapter 4

1. We have nothing on our own. We have no power. It is our God above who supplies us with strength, integrity, and honor to be used as a testimony to His greatness.
